Stop at the 83 metres tall Montmorency Falls, one of the most spectacular natural wonders of the Beauvre Coast. Make sure to take a breathtaking picture from the middle of the bridge spanning the top of the falls!

- Galleries de la Capitale**  
The group can shop and explore Galleries de la Capitale with 252 stores and the Mega Parc, complete with a roller coaster, Ferris wheel, a skating rink, a rock climbing wall, bowling, and a full arcade. Students have an opportunity to shop at Place Laurier. With 350 stores, there is something for everyone.

- 10:00am **Self guided visit of the Musee National des Beaux-Arts**
