Day Two

Continental breakfast at your hotel.

- 8:30am Board your motor coach.
- 9:00am **Bunker Hill Monument**
Arrive at the Bunker Hill Monument. Your Tour Leader explains the events leading up to the famous battle fought between the American colonists and the powerful British on June 17, 1775.
- 10:00am **USS Constitution Warship & Museum**
America's naval history is explored with a visit to the USS Constitution or "Old Ironsides", the oldest commissioned warship afloat in the world.
- 11:00am **Freedom Trail - Charleston Navy Yard to Faneuil Hall**
Begin your walk along the Freedom Trail from the Charleston Navy Yard. Your guide will tell the the stories of Boston's rich history. Following the red line path, the group will catch all the highlights, which include Paul Revere House, Copps Hill Burial Ground, the Old North Church and Faneuil Hall.
- 12:00pm Own arrangements for lunch at Quincy Market.

- 1:30pm **Freedom Trail - Quincy Market to Boston Common**
Continue your walk of the Freedom Trail from the Boston Massacre Site and the Old State House. The group will pass the Old Corner Bookstore, Granary Burial Ground and State House.
- 2:30pm Board your motor coach.
- 4:00pm **Salem Witch Museum**
The Salem Witch Museum brings you back to Salem Witch Trials of 1692. Visitors are given a dramatic history lesson using stage sets, life-size figures, lighting and narration.
- 5:30pm Own arrangements for dinner in Salem.
- 7:00pm **Historic Salem Walking Tour**
On your Salem History Tour, led by a local historian, Salem's darkest hour and fanciful present is explored. Visit sites from the Witch hunt of 1692, and learn about the importance of Parker Brothers and Alexander Graham Bell to the city of Salem.
- 8:30pm Board your motor coach and return to your accommodation.

Day Three

- 9:30am **Plimoth Plantation, Mayflower II Ship and Plymouth Rock**
The group visits Plimoth Plantation, a living history museum of 17th-century Plymouth and the Pilgrims that lived there. Following your visit to the Plantation, step on board the Mayflower II where you will hear stories of the hardship on the voyage to America.
- 12:30pm Own arrangements for lunch in Plymouth.
- 2:00pm Board your motor coach.
- 5:00pm **Explore Harvard University**
Tour of the grounds of Harvard University conducted by your Tour Leader. Harvard University is the oldest institution of higher learning in the United States.
