

Day One

- 7:30am Arrival at your school of an air-conditioned, washroom equipped, climate controlled highway motor coach.

- 2:00pm **Canadian Museum of Civilization - Visit**
The building itself is an architectural masterpiece and one of the largest museums in the world. Exceptional exhibits present 100,000 years of Canadian prehistory, history and culture.

Participate in the Canada Hall Rally. In small groups, students will travel across the country from East to West, through 1,000 years of Canadian history while answering questions about the exhibits.

- 9:00am **National Gallery of Canada - Self Guided Visit**
One of the architectural jewels of Ottawa, the National Gallery of Canada contains paintings and sculptures from around the world. Works by Picasso, Van Gogh, Warhol, and the Group of Seven are some of the thousands displayed for everyone to enjoy.
- 11:00am **Currency Museum - Money Matters Workshop**
Students will investigate different aspects of Canadian bank notes such as their history, the steps involved in printing them, their security features and their design.
- 12:30pm Own arrangements for lunch in the Byward Market. This is also a perfect opportunity to do some souvenir shopping.
- 2:30pm **Parliament Hill Rally**
Participate in the historical mystery rally on the monuments of Parliament Hill conducted by your Tour Leader.
- 3:30pm Prior to entering the Centre Block, every visitor must go through security. Line up for your security screening.
- 4:00pm **Parliament Hill Centre Block Tour**
Situated on a cliff overlooking the Ottawa River, the Parliament Buildings are historical monuments, architectural treasures, and an important national symbol cherished by all Canadians. It is within the walls of these buildings that Senators and Members of Parliament debate the important issues of the day, and make our nation's laws.
- 6:00pm **Buffet Dinner at Fun Junction**
- 7:00pm **Fun Junction: Laser Tag, Rock, Mini Golf + 10 Tokens**
Choose from laser tag, rock climbing, glow in the dark mini-putt and video arcade games.
